I'm sure you are already aware that our first topic is Geography based and we will be investigating our local area, focusing on the physical features of the Pewsey Downs. In term 2 we will be exploring life as an ancient Egyptian.

Our English this term will include: Recounts, Story, Poetry and Persuasion—all linked to our Geography or History Topic.

In Maths we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, geometry and measures.

Spelling will continue to be on a Monday, with the children being split into groups across the key stage. We will start our spelling lessons on Monday 11th September. (The children were assessed for this at the end of last year, so they could be placed in the most appropriate group).

Children will be having **PE on Wednesday and Friday** for the first two terms— Dance on Wednesday and football on Fridays. Please could I ask that everyone has shorts for indoor PE?
