I hope you all had a very Merry Christmas holiday and are all looking forward to the Spring terms of 2017.

Our term 3 topic is 'Wish you were here!', a geography themed topic in which we will be investigating Europe and the Mediterranean countries in particular. In term 4 we will be finding out about the lives of Victorian children in our Vile Victorians topic - 'It's a hard knock life'.

Our English this Spring will include: story, setting and character descriptions, poetry and persuasive texts - all linked to our geography and history topics.

In Maths we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction, fractions, multiplication and division, geometry and measures.

Spelling will continue to be on a Monday, with the children being split into groups across KS2. We will start our spelling lessons on Monday 9th January. (The children were assessed for this at the end of last term, so they could be placed in the most appropriate group).

Children will continue having **PE on Tuesday and Thursday**. Tuesday is tag rugby and it is our turn to have Judo on Thursday afternoons. Please could I ask that everyone has shorts for judo and warm clothes (jogging bottoms and sweatshirt) for rugby.
