Welcome to the February newsletter.

Although brief, the following news should update you with events happening in school during the new few weeks.

'Fun Club' - notice of increased charges

Our after-school child-care facility, 'Fun Club' has now been operating for almost four and a half years.

During that time, many pupils have enjoyed socialising, arts, crafts, IT, outdoor activities, the opportunity to get their homework underway and tea time refreshments after school, and their parents have enjoyed the security and flexibility of on-site child-care supervised by staff

well known to their children.

The running costs of 'Fun Club' have increased over the time it has been in operation, but until now the cost of the sessions has remained the same. In order that our childcare offer can remain viable, we will be increasing our charges by £1.00 per price band from the be-

ginning of Term 5 (after Easter).

Warning of Hand, Foot & Mouth Disease

We have had one confirmed incidence of Hand, Foot and Mouth disease in the lower school this week. The symptoms are: three to five days after contact with the virus a runny nose, sore throat, fever and loss of appetite may develop. This can be mistaken for a cold. A few days later children usually develop a blister-like rash on the hands, feet and mouth. The disease lasts for about 5 - 7 days and usually gets better without treatment. There is no need for children to stay away from school once their temperature is normal and they feel well.
