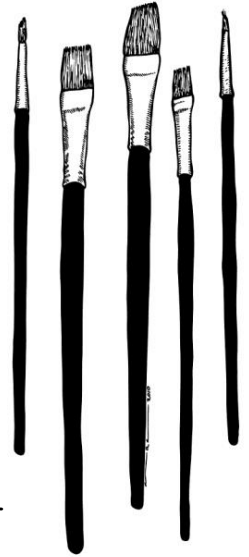
Reinvigorate your lesson plans with creative activities that kids love. These workshops include new and exciting ways to engage children in the classroom!!!

28th Jan 2017 - Wet Weather Play - Are you ever in need of extra ideas to keep the children occupied during those long wet days? This is the workshop for you - fun, creative ideas to keep everyone happy!!! - £25 per person
