Thursday, 11 February / 6.30pm Dr Mark Fife

Dr Mark Fife is a disease geneticist who works at The Pirbright Institute, a leading institute researching animal health. Mark recently returned from a stint in Sierra Leone where he worked for DFID as a senior member of Britain's emergency response team to the Ebola outbreak.

Thursday, 14 April / 6.30pm Verity Sharp

Verity Sharp is an award winning Music and Arts broadcaster who has presented a wide variety of radio and television programmes for the BBC. Verity also carries out voiceover work for documentaries and audio guides.

Tuesday, 17 May / 7pm Edward de Beukelar

Edward de Beukelar DVM MRCVS is a veterinary surgeon based in Marlborough. He trained in Antwerp and has practiced in the UK and France. He practices conventional medicine with homeopathy as a speciality. He is President of the International Association of Veterinary Homeopaths and has published 'Homeopathy What to Expect? Including 101 lively veterinary case studies'.

Thursday, 23 June / 6.30pm Professor Wade Allison

Professor Wade Allison is an Emeritus professor of Physics and Fellow of Keble College at Oxford University. His areas of focus have included Particle Physics, Nuclear and Medical Physics. He lectures and talks internationally and has published three books.
