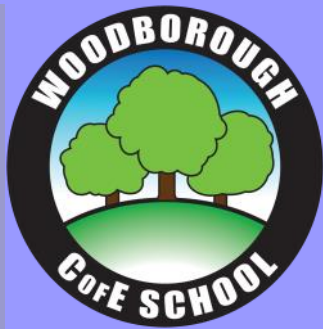

This year we have taken the time to focus on our own school grounds - to appreciate the lovely space we have and to think about ways in which we'd like to make some thoughtful improvements.

All classes have been assigned a raised bed at the front of the school and we're looking forward to having some advice and support from the Woodborough Whitehall Garden Centre about making the most of them throughout the whole year.



Additionally, all classes have focused their thoughts on different areas of the school grounds and have made 'wish lists' of ways they'd like them to be enhanced...



Oak Class are very keen to add some colour to their own outdoor area - painting the fence, adding curtains to their stage and installing a playhouse. **Sycamore Class** want to improve the Friendship Stop - adding a



Buddy Bench and colourful planters. **Maple Class** have great ideas to add numbers and phonics to the front of the school and also a time-



line of historical events. **Cherry Class** have focussed on the boat and would like to install a steering wheel, more seating, some mulch to keep the puddles at bay and add some eye-catching flags. **Elm Class** have plans to transform Finlay's Gardens with tuneful wind chimes.



Lime Class have grand ideas to upgrade the playhouse, adding a chalkboard inside, animal silhouettes outside and some cleverly designed tyre seats too. Finally, **Willow Class** are very keen to have an outdoor space where they can complete group work right outside their classroom.



They've got some planting troughs ordered and are keen to plant herbs, fruit and vegetables as well as bee-friendly plants in their raised bed.
