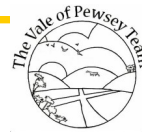

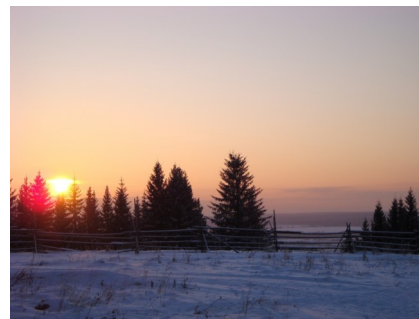
The Vestry Hour
