and you can download a file to make your own box at home, or in any way that will help you remember our young brothers and sisters in Nzara.




### Lent Lunches on Zoom

## Ash Wednesday

### Wednesday 17th February 10am

We will begin Lent with a live-streamed service on [valeofpewsey.org](http://valeofpewsey.org) and on our Facebook page.

This will be a Eucharist for Ash Wednesday including ashing.

We encourage you to join in whatever way you find most helpful:

1. You might like to make the sign of the cross for yourself in your forehead in ash. This could be made (with care!) from a Palm cross from previous year, or ash from paper or your fire. Mix it with a small amount of olive oil to make a paste.

2. You could collect a stone or prayer card with an ash cross from St John's Church Pewsey anytime from 15th February to use in your prayers on that day and throughout Lent. The church is open every day from 9am-4pm.
