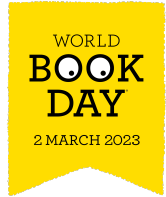




Book Week 2023

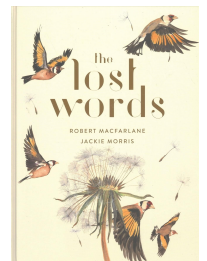


Monday 27th February - Friday 3rd March

Book Week is fast approaching (Monday 27th February - Friday 3rd March) so we thought we would give you some information about what we will be up to at school during that week.

This year, we have a poetry focus. Our learning in English will be based around the book 'The Lost Words' by Robert Macfarlane and Jackie Morris. The Lost Words is a 'book of spells' that seeks to conjure back the near-lost magic and strangeness of the nature that surrounds us.



Each class will focus on a different poem from the book, developing the use of language through description, alliteration, repetition, rhyme and personification to name but a few!

During the week, children will also be taking part in online book week events with famous authors and illustrators who will share their love of books and reading with children and adults throughout the school.

On Friday 3rd March you are invited to join us for our **School Meeting** where each class will share their creativity and learning from the week.
