The Woodborough School '**PHOENIX**' Colour run/Walk is back by popular demand for a second year! We hope that you will find the following information useful and above all we hope everyone has a fun time taking part. We do have to throw in a few disclaimers so apologies in advance for that.

There are three distances to choose from: 5K, 2.5K and laps around the school track

The 5K and 2.5K courses are largely off-road, and all competitors enter at their own risk. While medical assistance is provided for the duration of the event no liability will be accepted by landowners or race organisers for any injury incurred by entering this race.

You can expect to be covered in coloured powder at various points along the way! The powder is organic and is not a risk to personal health or the environment. However, you are advised to wear eye protection in the form of goggles or sunglasses and so please bring some along. If you don't want to be covered in powder just hang back until its all gone!

White T Shirts will be provided for children participating to enhance the colourful experience. You may wish to bring protection for car seats before heading of home! Adults will need to bring their own T shirts, please

By registering to participate, you are accepting the school's terms and conditions

Pictures and video footage may be used on the school website or media write-ups. All competitors entering the fun run/walk agree to their photograph being used for these purposes.

On the day of the event:

- 5K and 2.5K distances for all ages - All children must be accompanied at all times whilst running by an adult responsible for them.
- A responsible adult may accompany up to 3 children outside their household with prior consent from a parent/guardian
- School Track distance aimed at YR and Y1- All children may run unaccompanied.
- Parents/Guardians remain responsible for their children whether running with them or not.

Entry Fees

There will be a £10 registration fee per family to cover the costs of putting on the event. This will cover the cost of the children's T Shirts, a pair of sunglasses (to keep the powder out of little eyes) and also a medal for all the children that participate.

If children could then raise minimum of £10 sponsorship, please, that would be fantastic.

By entering the race you are agreeing to be bound by the event Terms & Conditions set out here..

Event Day Registration

Please register your arrival at the desk on the day of the event. The desk will be open from 10:30am and will be located in the front playground area.

Event Start Time

A briefing will take place at 11:20am followed by a pre-event warm up at 11:25am.

All distances will commence at 11:30am- and prepared to be coloured up from the start!.

Parking

Parking will be available in the social club car park. There will be no parking at the school or in the layby. Please park with consideration for each other and our neighbours.

Start/Finish Area

Will be in the playground in front of the school, please approach through the pedestrian gate off of the bus layby.

Footwear

The terrain is mixed but largely off road, you are advised that trail shoes are most appropriate but regular running shoes/trainers are suitable for both routes. Please be advised that the routes follow footpaths. Every effort has been taken to ensure that clear safe routes are in place, but participants are responsible for their own safety.

Medical Conditions

It is recommended that you prepare and train for this event. www.runnersmedicalresource.com has guidance. Please consult your doctor for a check-up if you have not exercised for some time. If you have a medical condition please let us know in advance. We strongly advise you seek medical advice before participating in this event and you disclose to those medical advisors the nature of this event.

Safety

This is a multi-terrain event, often uneven underfoot and there are a few stiles to negotiate. All competitors accept by registering that they enter at their own risk. While medical assistance is provided for the duration of the event, no liability will be accepted by either Woodborough CofE School, the PTA or land owners, or individual race organisers for any injury incurred by entering this race.

Children remain the responsibility of their parents/guardians.

Please keep to footpaths and follow the way markers or directions given by marshals on the routes. Do not stray onto private land or into farm buildings.

Race Timing and Distances

This is not an officially timed event and the distances have been checked but are approximate. This event is just for fun!

Dogs

Unfortunately for the safety of runners we can't allow dogs to accompany participants on this event.

Water Stations

There will be no water stations on the routes so if you require water please make arrangements to carry this with you. Bottled water will be available to purchase on the day at registration. It may be hot on the day - lets hope for good weather anyway!

Please dispose of any water bottles on completion of the event in the recycling bins provided.

Toilet Facilities

Toilet facilities are available in the School. We cannot offer changing facilities, unfortunately.

Left Baggage

There will be a left baggage area where you may leave your possessions whilst participating. Please ensure that these are in a named bag. This will be attended at all times on the day, but no responsibility can be taken for the safety and security of items left.

Post Race Refreshments and Activities

Please stay on for the school late summer fete as there will be plenty of refreshments and a BBQ (WITH BAR SELLING HARD AND SOFT DRINKS!) to revive tired bodies!

We will also have an **inflatable assault course** suitable for all ages of children who still, no doubt, have energy to spare, along with face painting, a sweets stall, tattoos and other activities to be announced.

Prizegiving

Medals will be given to all children who participate in any of the distances. These will be given out at the finish.
