Welcome to the first two terms of the 2015–2016 academic year. We have all settled in well over the last three days and are now looking forward to all this year brings.

I'm sure you are already aware that our first topic is the Anglo Saxons and in term 2 it will be Science—Living Things, Plants and Habitats, Animals including Humans.

Our English this term will include: Recounts, Poetry and Legends—all linked to our History Topic. In Maths we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction, fractions, multiplication and division, geometry, shape and measures.

Spelling will continue to be on a Monday, with the children being split into groups across KS2. The children have been assessed for this today so they can be placed in the most appropriate group.

Thank you very much for the lovely Extreme Reading Challenges that have been sent into school. I have enjoyed reading them and have passed them on to Mrs Brewis. The Spelling Bee will begin next Monday, during our spelling lesson.

Children will be having **PE on Tuesday and Wednesday** for the first two terms—football on Tuesday and badminton on Wednesdays. Please could I ask that everyone has shorts for indoor PE?
