Happy New Year! Welcome to the Spring terms of 2016. We have had a good first week and are already enjoying our new topics and looking forward to the rest of the term.

Thank you to all of the pupils that found time to have a look at our new Geography topic - I was very impressed by the interesting facts you found and the fantastic 'Water Cycles' that some of you drew. In term 3 our topic will be Science and D&T - Forces and Construction and Mechanics.

Our English this term will include: explanations, poetry and story writing. Next term we will also look at instructions. Book Week is the week commencing 29th February. Spelling will continue to be on a Monday, with the children being split into groups across KS2.

In Maths we will be looking at: place value, including decimal numbers (in context of money); addition and subtraction, mental and formal written strategies, up to 6 digit numbers; fractions and their related decimals and percentages; multiplication and division; data, geometry and measures.

Children will continue to have **PE on Tuesday and Wednesday** for the first eight weeks - rugby on Tuesday and dance on Wednesdays. Please could I ask that everyone has shorts for indoor PE? Some children will be swimming on Wednesdays (they have been contacted separately). After the first 8 weeks we will start Judo (10.3.16); which will be on a Thursday afternoon. Our timetable will therefore change to accommodate this. As Judo runs for 8 weeks it will go into the Summer Term. (Lime N will follow us.)
