## Homework Timetable for Autumn Term 1 & 2

- Spellings and a task designed to build on the spelling pattern.
- A piece of written English homework, this may include comprehensions.
- Maths homework based on what has been done in class during the week.
- Reading each night to an adult and have this recorded in your homework diaries
- Learn your times tables for multiplication awards at the end of each term.

Welcome back to the start of another school year. The children have returned enthusiastic and keen to learn - a fantastic start! Don't forget to send in any Extreme Read Challenges, we have already shared a few with one another and we are looking forward to reading some more.

We have already been working hard on our first topic, Anglo Saxons. In Term 2 we will switch to Science, focusing on Plants and Habitats, Animals including Humans. If the children have any books they wish to share with the class on these topics then these are very welcomed; all I ask is that they are labelled in some way with your child's name.

Our English this term will include: Recounts, Poetry and Legends—all linked, where possible, to our History Topic. Spelling will continue to be on a Monday, with the children being split into groups across KS2. The children have been assessed for this today so they can be placed in the most appropriate group. The Spelling Bee will begin next Monday, 14th September, during our spelling lesson.

In Maths we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction, fractions, multiplication and division, geometry, shape and measures.

For the first term the children will be having **Badminton** on a **Wednesday** and **Football** outside on a **Friday**. This will then change to Gym (Wednesday) and Netball (Friday).

I have included a copy of our weekly timetable but please understand that as teachers we have to be flexible and sometimes last minute changes have to be made! Over the weekend the children were required to read, practice their Spelling Bee words and check their login details for Mathletics. Formal homework will begin this week.

### A brief overview of some of the topics planned for the Autumn Term

**Science:** Living things, Plants and habitats, Animals including humans.
