

All children at the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) and Key Stage 2 (Year 6) undertake Standard Assessment Tests (SATs).

Teacher assessment and SATs results have equal status. Teacher assessments may vary from SATs results because they are based upon a teacher's knowledge of a pupil formed over a period of time in that subject, rather than a short, externally set test. Parents are informed of the teacher assessments at parents' evenings and through reports.

Level 4 should challenge a typical 11 year old.
