

Welcome to our revised new School Newsletter which we hope to publish more regularly to keep everyone up to date with important information and things that are happening in and around our school



It was great to be joined by so many interested parents and to share information about the role of the Governing Body, our ideas and aspirations for the future of our school and to receive your questions and feedback.


We will be happy to host more regular Open Meetings if there is sufficient support for a similar event in the future.
