Our Art Week this year takes place in the week of 22nd - 26th June. The focus for this year will be '**Music and Art**' and will be based around the 'BBC Ten Pieces initiative. Ten Pieces aims to inspire a generation of children to get creative with classical music.

Back in the autumn term Key Stage 2 pupils had the opportunity to visit Salisbury to view the Ten Pieces film at the cinema. Children in Key Stage 1 watched the DVD at school later in the term. Throughout the winter and spring terms all the classes have been looking at the music in their Tuesday music sessions with Mrs Beresford. Now this summer term we are bringing it all together in a week-long celebration of music and creativity. The classes will be getting arty and preparing some performance work during the week and we will have our usual Open Gallery on the afternoon of Friday 26th June (from 2pm).
