Book Week is fast approaching ( $27^{th}$  February –  $3^{th}$  March) and I hope this letter will give you some details about what we'll be up to.

The theme this year will be **Take One Book**. We will reveal which book the school will explore on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> in **THE BIG REVEAL**. All classes will be exploring the same book but they will have a different age relevant version. Each class will be busy with their own activities; however there will be some common themes...

## Monday 27th February 2017

This year we will be holding **The Big Book Swap**. Each child is invited to bring in a book that is in good condition but that they have already read and enjoyed – it should be appropriate for their own age group. The idea is that everyone in the school will swap a book and go home at the end of the day with a new story to enjoy and keep.

**Bedtime Story** will be from 6pm-6.45pm. Children are invited back in their PJ's and accompanied by their teddy bears if they wish. Anyone who would like to read a story can sign up on the list outside the school office. New readers are always appreciated!
