### Arrangements for Sports Day 2018

Our annual Sports Day is on **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> July**. It will commence at 9.00 am with an Opening Ceremony and parents are invited to watch for the whole day. KS2 (Cherry, Elm and Willow Classes) will take part in the morning, between 9 am and 12noon and KS1 (Oak, Sycamore and Maple Classes) will compete in the afternoon, between 1 pm and 3 pm.

A race for pre-school children will take place straight after lunch – all pre-schoolers very welcome! However, a polite reminder that toddlers must be supervised by adults and should stay in the spectators' area, away from the race track during all other events.

### Lunch arrangements



Lunchtime will be between 12 noon and 1 pm.

At lunchtime, parents are invited to join their children for a picnic lunch on the field. **We will not be catering for hot lunches on Sports Day.**

If your child is in years R-2 or eligible for Free School Meals, please select a packed lunch option from the menu that has just been uploaded to school gateway. All bookings must be made **by Wednesday 11th July** to allow the kitchen time to order the correct quantities. Unfortunately we will be unable to cater for any late orders and a lunch will need to be provided from home.

Children in years 3-6, not in receipt of Free School Meals, will need to bring a packed lunch on this day. All bookings for hot meals made in advance have been cancelled so you will not be charged.
