We hope you have had a great summer, we are very excited to begin a fresh new year and have already made a brilliant start.

You are probably already aware that our first topic is 'May the Force Be With You' ; a science based topic where we will work as scientists, exploring different forces including magnetism. We will also be investigating sources of light, how light travels, shadows and mirrors.

This topic is linked to our English work where we are building our work around the book *The Iron Man*. We will be writing descriptions of settings and characters and then moving to poetry.

Next terms topic will be History based; 'We Will Remember Them' is about WW1 and WW2 and we will be writing recounts, diaries and factual accounts.

In Maths we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction, and multiplication and division.

We will also be busy with all the other curriculum areas, for a full breakdown of our term's overview see the school website.

Spelling will continue to be on a Monday, with the children being split into groups across the key stage.

Children will be doing PE on Monday and Friday for the next two terms – we will be covering dance, gymnastics, netball and football so please make sure that indoor and outdoor kit is available.
