Dear Year 5 & 6 Parents,

Residential Visit 3rd – 7th June 2019, to Rockley Point, Poole, Dorset

The annual, summer term, residential visits made by our Year 5 and 6 pupils are always looked forward to by pupils, staff (and parents) alike and it is time to announce plans for the next one.

During the week 3rd – 7th June 2019 inclusive we are returning to Rockley Point, Poole, Dorset. Rockley Point is the UK watersports centre for Rockley Adventure, based on the shores of Europe's largest natural harbor in Poole, Dorset. The centre is able to offer unrivaled conditions for watersports, operating in a safe, shallow and sheltered area.

It is my hope that all pupils in Years 5 and 6 might take the opportunity to participate in the residential visit this year. As well as being an excellent way of meeting the requirements of the outdoor and adventurous activities elements of the National Curriculum, such visits provide a wealth of valuable social and character-building opportunities for all who participate. Please be aware that if children do not take part in the visit, their attendance will be required at school for the week and absences will be unauthorised in the normal manner.

The total cost will be £400, to include all transport, food and activities (if we can reduce this nearer the time with cheaper transport costs we will pass any savings made back to parents). I hope that this amount will not be prohibitive and would urge any parents with concerns to contact me at school, in confidence. There are a number of means available to us that could assist with funding.

We have included two suggested payment plans which we hope will enable parents to spread the cost of the trip but also to ensure we meet the strict payment deadlines set by Rockley Adventure. The 1st and 2nd deposit dates and the balancing payment are set by the centre.

In order to book a place for your child, please complete and return the attached slip to school by **Monday 1st October** at the latest, enclosing a non-refundable deposit of **£110**. **Please also return the slip if your child will not be taking part.**
