# Medical Arrangements

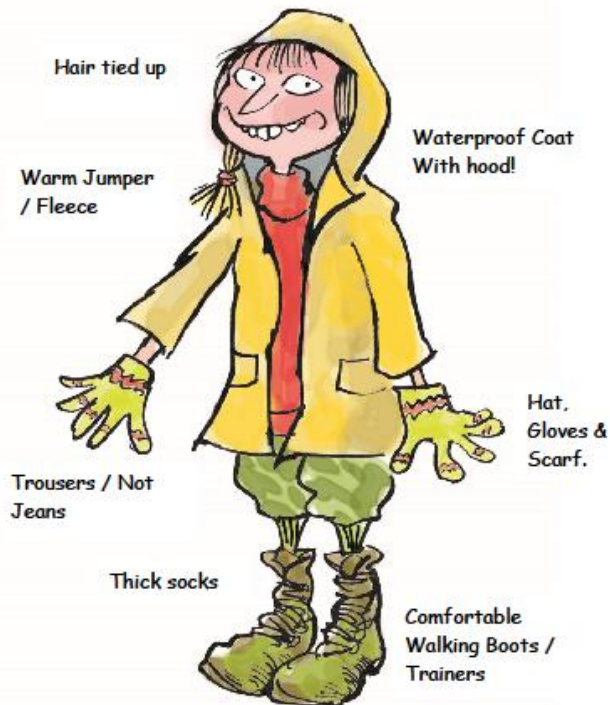
- All medicines should be clearly labelled

# **Responsibility and Independence**

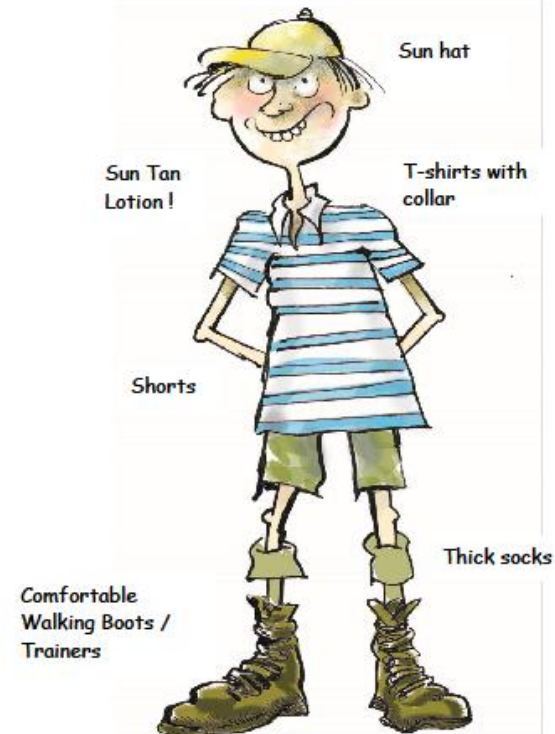
- **Being prepared for every activity**
