Welcome to Year 3 !

We hope you have had a great summer, we are very excited to begin a fresh new year and have lots of exciting things planned.

Our first topic is a geography topic called 'Where in the world?' We will be looking at atlases and Google Earth to find where we live and all about the places around us. We will be particularly looking at Europe so if you have visited any European countries this summer we would love to see pictures.

This topic is linked to our English work where we are investigating atlases and looking at poetry.

Next term's topic will be Science based; 'We will rock you' is about rocks and fossils. We will be looking at the formation of fossils and the work of Mary Anning. We will be writing explanations and biographies to support this work.

In Maths we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, measuring length and time, money, statistics, pictograms, fractions and geometry. The children are encouraged to keep practising their x-tables using the Times Tables Rock Star website or any other way they would prefer.

In RE, our first Christianity topic is 'Creation and Fall' followed by an Islam focus during next term.

We will also be busy with all the other curriculum areas, for a full breakdown of our term's overview see the school website.

Spelling will continue to be on a Monday, with the children being split into groups across the key stage.

Children will be doing PE on Tuesday and Thursday for the next two terms — we will be covering dance, gymnastics, netball and football, so please make sure that indoor and outdoor kit is available.

These are a busy two terms with lots of events coming up including Harvest Festival and Global Week so please keep an eye out for extra newsletters and messages via Seesaw.
