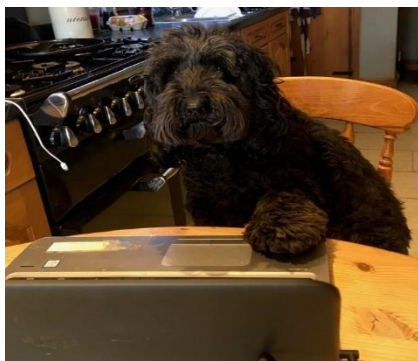


Kizzy's Easter Newsletter
