

Building progress update...

Work to reinstate our fire-damaged classrooms, staffroom and resource space is progressing well, and beneath the tarpaulins and scaffolding these areas are being reconfigured to be more conducive to their purposes.



Timber roof trusses and roofing felt have now been installed and we understand that in the next few days the site will begin to look quite different with the removal of the top layer of scaffolding and its covering.

As long as building materials and component parts continue to arrive on time, we believe that the work should be completed towards the end of the summer holiday, in time for us to move back in at the beginning of the new academic year.


