We will be studying two science units and a history and a geography unit working towards answering these enquiry questions:

Chemistry - "Does water always melt at the same speed?"

Geography - "What impact do volcanoes have on the people who live near them?"

In English, we will learn more complex spelling and grammar rules which we will be applying into our everyday writing.
