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Welcome back to the start of 2024, I hope you all had a relaxing Christmas and managed to fight of the coughs and colds that were doing the rounds at the end of term. This letter will give you key information about the SpringTerm and information on how to keep up to date with your children's work.







We are beginning the term with a Science topic on Everyday Materials which will continue through the Spring term. Alongside this, we will focus on History, in particular at the History of Transport. We are hoping to have a trip to STEAM museum in Swindon however this is likely to be at the start of Term 4 to give us time to finish the topic. We will then move onto our Geography unit looking at Continents of the world and animals that live there.

Mathematics and English lessons will take place daily. In maths, we will be focusing on, addition and subtraction within 20, fractions for half and quarter, place value to 50 and measurement. Alongside this, daily Phonics and Reading sessions will take place which will build the children's confidence with sounding out and blending in readiness for the Year 1 phonics screening check in June. In addition to our daily phonics lessons, we will have weekly spelling lessons which will cover the Year 1 spelling objectives.

I am really pleased how quickly they have settled back into their work after the Christmas break. We have parents' evening in March and details about how this will take place will be sent out nearer the time.
