The following information will explain the plans for Cherry Class over the next two terms.


Curriculum

Our Science, for both Summer terms, will be focussed on Plants and Animals. We begin with a look at plants in our topic called Blooming Marvellous where we investigate what makes plants healthy and the different roles of the parts of a plant.

This will be followed by a look at animals and conservation. Our Class book this term is The Last Bear and it will support this topic work well. We will be writing persuasively about climate change and then later in the

Geography lessons will link in well as we are exploring the amazon rainforest and river– looking at the people, plants and animals that live there.



As we have now finished swimming, PE will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. As many of you are aware Mrs Barratt has been busy this year training to be a Forest School leader and we hope to launch our Forest School sessions with Year 3 over these summer terms—more news on this to follow.

In Wednesday's PE lessons we will be outside, please ensure that children have appropriate PE kit on these days. Children will require jumpers, tracksuit bottoms and suitable footwear for the field.

Our first RE unit this term is an Islam unit focusing on the Quran and Muslim beliefs. In the final term we will be returning to Christianity and considering what kind of world Jesus wanted?

<u>Homework</u>

We have been really impressed with Cherry Class reading this year with lots of children reading 5x a week, there is always a lot of excitement when the name is drawn out of the hat for the book vending machine Thank you so much for supporting the children at home; it makes a huge difference to their learning in school.

We will continue to set English homework each week and this will either be linked to our topic or grammar/comprehension focused.

Maths homework will be given out on a Tuesday, to be handed in the following Monday. This follows up on previous learning so if you child is struggling please let us know.

In addition, the children should be learning times tables and related division facts continually as they work towards improving their results in our termly Multiplication Awards. Times Table Rock Stars is a great resource to aid with this but it is not compulsory, any practice is great.
