### Dear Parents,

I hope you have all had an enjoyable and relaxing Easter break. This newsletter will give you more details of the children's learning for the Summer Term.

#### <u>Curriculum</u>

Science: Plants and animals (inc humans), Geography: Coastlines, History: The History of Wiltshire.

We are starting off Term 5 studying the history of Wiltshire and how it has changed over time. We will be looking at historical landmarks in Wiltshire and carefully observe how life in Wiltshire has changed since the first settlers arrived. In term 6, we will be looking at coastlines and will learn about ocean tides and how rocks and coastlines are formed either naturally or by man. Our science this term will be studying what plants and animals need to survive and we will be looking closely at what constitutes a balanced diet.

Mathematics and English lessons will take place daily. In maths, we will be focusing on different calculation strategies. Daily spelling and reading sessions will continue to take place and we will be writing a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts that will be linked to our topic based learning. We also begin practising for our annual Sports Day by beginning each day with our 'Golden Mile'.

At the end of this term, I will be sending out more details about our class assembly in Term 6!
