

Homework

The children are expected to read at home 5 times a week.

Children of this age like to read by themselves and this should be encouraged as it builds reading stamina and allows them to tackle longer, more detailed books. It is also important that they read to an adult as it will enable them to discuss plot development, characterisation and improve comprehension skills.

In the lead up to SATS there will be a slightly different format for homework. After SATS week, normal homework will resume—being given out on a Friday and due in the following Thursday.

Curriculum
